- (a) Table of fees for inspecting and testing of device at request of the owner or user authorized by Section 12210 and 12210.5 of the California Business and Professions Code for noncommercial and commercial devices. On and after 7/1/18, the fees shall be the lower of either the State authorized maximum or the County's full recovery cost, based on the Auditor-Controller's determination of actual costs. The Auditor-Controller shall prepare a cost recovery analysis for each fee that is adjusted by the state, at least as often as the state adjusts a fee.

- (b) Pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 12240, the annual registration fee shall consist of 1) the applicable location fee, and 2) all applicable general device fees, gas/electric/water meter fees, livestock scale fees, weighing devices, stationary and truck mounted LPG meter fees, compressed natural gas meter, wholesale and vehicle meter fees, and price scanner fees.
